




COMPANY PROFILE




OUR VISION


PRODUCTS



- Top producer of agricultural bags in Northern Nigeria
- Woven polypropylene bags in various sizes and colours (including transparent) depending on the need
- Used for the storage of rice, corn, wheat, vegetables and fruits. Can also be used for storing cotton



- Laminated polypropylene woven bags
- Can accommodate various sizes and designs
- Used for shopping etc.



- Highest quality polypropylene twisted yarns
- Can be used as sewing ropes



PRODUCTS



- Laminated top/bottom welded polypropylene bags used mostly for cement storage
- Can also be used to store flour



- Flexible Intermediate Bulk Containers
- Available in different shapes and sizes – 2 tonne jumbo bags, travel bags, school bags
- Can be used as an industrial container to transport large dry products such as sugar, granules, sand, and chemicals

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY




Fas Agro is a real and active partner in the progress of our community. We are heavily invested in the development of our surroundings and the protection of the environment.



COLLABORATION WITH CBN

The Central Bank of Nigeria's constant support has been a key factor in establishing Fas Agro as one of the biggest manufacturers of polypropylene bags in Nigeria. CBN's backing allowed Fas Agro to grow and cement its commitment towards strengthening Nigeria's economy and job creation.

PROMISE

After a promise was made to the then governor of the central bank (he advised us to go into industry to help Nigeria) that we are determined to play a role in helping Nigeria through economic and job growth, we started Fas Agro in 1989 as a small manufacturing company.



COMMITMENT

We received 2 SME loans from CBN, each with a value of \$1.5 million. This helped us double our capacity each time. We also repaid fully each of the loans within 2 of the 5 year period allowed.

- Consumption of 100 tons of polypropylene a day
















